14:10pm	Men 40 plus, 50 plus, 60 plus	approx 10km

In accordance with UKA rules age is determined by age on the day of Competition.

Individual awards will be made in five year age bands up to 69. Gold, Silver and Bronze (1st, 2nd and 3rd) 70+ Counts as one band.

Team awards (3 to score) (1st, 2nd, 3rd) awards will be in ten year age bands (40/50/60)

**Entry Fee is £9.00 per person (NO TEAM FEE)**

## **CONDITIONS & DETAILS**

Meeting will be held under UKA Rules.

Only one team per club in each age band will be eligible for an award.

All competing athletes must be first claim members of their club and registered with England Athletics.

Anyone whose transfer has been approved by England Athletics but is ineligible for team competition may be entered as an individual

**Entries on the day will not be accepted.**

An athlete may ONLY compete in one age group – e.g. an over 50 women may compete for the over 40 team but may ONLY score as an individual in that particular age group

Runners, who wish to count for a younger team instead of their own age group, **MUST** declare this on the entry form and this **CANNOT** be changed on the DAY. **This means that you can only qualify for the medal in the team race for which you are entered.**
